

ACCOUNTING AND MANAGEMENT REVIEW BEST PAPER AWARD

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Accounting and Management Review Award (henceforth, the 'AMR Award') is attributed by the Portuguese Institute of Chartered Accountants ('Ordem dos Contabilistas Certificados' – OCC) to recognise the best academic papers presented in the Grudis Annual Conference (hereafter, 'the Conference'), and whose authors have submitted their work to the Accounting and Management Review.
2. In the submission on the [AMR website](#), authors must indicate that they have submitted their work to the Grudis Conference.
3. The submission deadline is the same as that of the Grudis Conference.
4. The AMR Award consists of a certificate and a prize of 500 euros, awarded to each of the best papers distinguished among those eligible for the award.
5. To be eligible for the AMR Award, authors must: (i) explicitly indicate, during the conference submission process, their intention to compete for the award; and (ii) submit their paper to the Accounting and Management Review through the following link: [Submissions | Accounting and Management Review | Revista de Contabilidade e Gestão](#)
6. The number of AMR Awards available annually is subject to a maximum of three papers and a minimum of one.
7. The decision to grant the AMR Award to papers is informed by the Conference reviewers' recommendations and made by the Editorial Board of the Accounting and Management Review.
8. The Editorial Board of the Accounting and Management Review is accountable for the final decision on the number of papers to be awarded.
